The Personal Injuries (Civilians) (Amendment) Scheme 2005

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Personal Injuries (Civilians) (Amendment) Scheme 2005 and shall come into force—
 - (a) for the purposes of this article, article 2 and paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to this Scheme, on 6th April 2005.
 - (b) for the purposes of paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of Schedule 1 to this Scheme, on 11th April 2005.
- (2) In this Scheme, "the principal Scheme" means the Personal Injuries (Civilians) Scheme 1983(1), and, except where the context otherwise requires, a reference to a numbered article, Part, Table or Schedule is to the article, Part, Table or Schedule in the principal Scheme which bears that number.

Amendments to the principal Scheme and application

2. The amendments to the principal Scheme contained in Schedule 1 to this Scheme shall have effect.
