# The Health and Safety (Fees) Regulations 2005

Made - - - - 11th March 2005

Laid before Parliament 16th March 2005

Coming into force - - 6th April 2005

The Secretary of State, being the designated MI Minister for the purpose of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 M2 in relation to the notification and control of substances, the control and regulation of genetically modified organisms and measures relating to the prevention and limitation of the effects of accidents involving dangerous substances, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the said section 2(2) and sections 43(2), (4), (5) and (6) and 82(3)(a) of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 M3 ("the 1974 Act") and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and for the purpose of giving effect without modifications to proposals submitted to him by the Health and Safety Commission under section 11(2)(d) of the 1974 Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:
