SCHEDULE 1

AMENDMENTS TO THE PRISON RULES 1999

1. In paragraph (1) of rule 2 (interpretation), for the definition of "adjudicator" substitute—
""adjudicator" means a District Judge (Magistrates' Courts) or Deputy District Judge (Magistrates' Courts)(1) approved by the Lord Chancellor for the purpose of inquiring into a charge which has been referred to him;".
