UK CROSS BORDER MOVEMENT OF HAZARDOUS WASTE

5. Where a cross border consignment into England from Scotland or Northern Ireland [^{F1}or Wales] is accepted, the consignee shall send a copy of the cross border consignment note to SEPA (where the waste is transported from Scotland) or the Northern Ireland Department of the Environment (where the waste is transported from Northern Ireland) [^{F2}or the Natural Resources Body for Wales (where the waste is transported from Wales)].
