This Order makes provision in relation to service courts in consequence of Part 9 of the Criminal Justice Act 2003 (c. 44) as amended by section 30 of the Domestic Violence, Crime and Victims Act 2004 (c. 28). Section 31(7) of the 2001 Act was amended by section 91(1) of the Crime (International Co-operation) Act 2003 (c. 32).
