**The Housing Benefit Regulations 2006**

**PART 1**

General

**Persons who have attained the qualifying age for state pension credit**

5.—(1) These Regulations apply to a person who—

- (a) has not attained the qualifying age for state pension credit; or
- (b) has attained the qualifying age for state pension credit if he, or if he has a partner, his partner, is a person [<sup>F1</sup>on universal credit,] on income support[<sup>F2</sup>, on an income-based jobseeker's allowance or on an income-related employment and support allowance].

<sup>F3</sup>(2) .....

(3) Except as provided in [<sup>F4</sup>paragraph (1)] , these Regulations shall not apply in relation to any person if he, or if he has a partner, his partner, has attained the qualifying age for state pension credit.
