Severe Disability Premium

 - (ii) subject to sub-paragraph (4), he has no non-dependants aged 18 or over normally residing with him or with whom he is normally residing; and

- (iii) no person is entitled to, and in receipt of, a carer's allowance under section 70 of the Act [F56] or has an award of universal credit which includes the carer element] in respect of caring for him;
- (b) in the case of a claimant who has a partner—
 - (i) the claimant is in receipt of attendance allowance, [F57the care component of disability living allowance at the highest or middle rate prescribed in accordance with section 72(3) of the Act[F58], the care component of child disability payment at the highest or middle rate in accordance with regulation 11(5) of the DACYP Regulations[F59], the daily living component of personal independence payment at the standard or enhanced rate in accordance with section 78(3) of the 2012 Act[F60], the daily living component of adult disability payment at the standard or enhanced rate in accordance with regulation 5 of the Disability Assistance for Working Age People (Scotland) Regulations 2022[F61] or armed forces independence payment]]; and
 - (ii) his partner is also in receipt of such an allowance [F62 or payment] or, if he is a member of a polygamous marriage, all the partners of that marriage are in receipt of such an allowance [F62 or payment]; and
 - (iii) subject to sub-paragraph (4), the claimant has no non-dependants aged 18 or over normally residing with him or with whom he is normally residing,

and either a person is [F63 entitled to and in receipt of] a carer's allowance [F56 or has an award of universal credit which includes the carer element] in respect of caring for only one of a couple or, in the case of a polygamous marriage, for one or more but not all the partners of the marriage, or as the case may be, no person is entitled to and in receipt of such an allowance [F64 or has such an award of universal credit] in respect of caring for either member of a couple or any partner of a polygamous marriage.

- (3) Where a claimant has a partner who does not satisfy the condition in sub-paragraph (2)(b)(ii), and that partner is [F65] severely sight impaired or blind or treated as severely sight impaired or blind] within the meaning of paragraph (1)(a)(v) and (2), that partner shall be treated for the purposes of sub-paragraph (2) as if he were not a partner of the claimant.
 - (4) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (2)(a)(ii) and (2)(b)(iii) no account shall be taken of—

PART 8

Amount of transitional addition

- **30.**—(1) Subject to paragraph 31, the amount of the transitional addition is the amount by which Amount A exceeds Amount B.
- (2) Where a conversion decision as described in regulation 5(2)(a) of the Employment and Support Allowance (Existing Awards) Regulations is made in respect of the relevant person—
 - (a) Amount A is the basic amount that would have applied on the day that decision took effect had that decision not been made; and
 - (b) Amount B is the basic amount that applied on that day as a result of that decision.
- (3) Where the relevant person is appealing a conversion decision as described in regulation 5(2) (b) of the Employment and Support Allowance (Existing Awards) Regulations and is treated as having limited capability for work by virtue of regulation 30 of the Employment and Support Allowance Regulations as modified by the Employment and Support Allowance (Existing Awards) Regulations—
 - (a) Amount A is the basic amount that would have applied on the day the relevant person was first treated as having limited capability for work if the relevant person had not been so treated; and
 - (b) Amount B is the basic amount that applied on that day as a result of the relevant person being so treated.
- (4) In this paragraph and paragraph 31, "basic amount" means the aggregate of such amounts as may apply in the claimant's case in accordance with regulation $22[^{F137}(1)](a)$ to (e) or regulation $23[^{F137}(1)](a)$ to (f).

- **31.**—(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), where there is a change of circumstances which leads to an increase in the claimant's basic amount, the transitional addition that applies immediately before the change of circumstances shall be reduced by the amount by which Amount C exceeds Amount D.
- (2) If Amount C exceeds Amount D by more than the amount of the transitional addition that applies immediately before the change of circumstances, that transitional addition shall be reduced to nil.
 - (3) Amount C is the basic amount that applies as a result of the increase.
 - (4) Amount D is the basic amount that applied immediately before the increase.]
