# Sums to be disregarded in the calculation of earnings

- 1. In the case of a claimant who has been engaged in remunerative work as an employed earner or, had the employment been in Great Britain, would have been so engaged—
  - (a) where—
    - (i) the employment has been terminated because of retirement; and
    - (ii) on retirement he is entitled to a retirement pension under the Act, or is not so entitled solely because of his failure to satisfy the contribution conditions,

any earnings [FI paid or due to be paid] in respect of that employment, but only for a period commencing on the day immediately after the date on which the employment was terminated;

# [F2(aa) where—

- (i) the employment has been terminated because of retirement; and
- (ii) on retirement he is entitled to a state pension under Part 1 of the Pensions Act 2014, or is not so entitled solely because he does not have the minimum number of qualifying years,

any earnings paid or due to be paid in respect of that employment, but only for a period commencing on the day immediately after the date the employment was terminated;]

any earnings paid or due to be paid in respect of that employment except any payment or remuneration of the nature described in r [ $^{F5}$ paragraph 1(b)(i) or (ii)(bb) or regulation 35(1) (i)] (i) or (j).]
