##### SECTION 1

##### *Claims and information*

#### Interpretation

**89.** In this Section—

[<sup>F1</sup> “ county council ” means a county council in England, but only if the council has made an arrangement in accordance with regulation 64(5)(g) or 90(3); ]

“local authority” means an authority administering housing benefit;

“relevant authority” means—

- (a) the Secretary of State;
- (b) a person providing services to the Secretary of State;<sup>[F2</sup> or
- (c) a county council;]

“relevant information” means information or evidence relating to the administration of claims to or awards of housing benefit.
