SCHEDULE 6

Capital to be disregarded

PART 1

Capital to be disregarded generally

17.—(1) An amount equal to the amount of any payment made in consequence of any personal injury to the claimant or, if the claimant has a partner, to the partner.

- (2) Where the whole or part of the payment is administered—
- [^{F1}(a) by the High Court or the County Court under Rule 21.11(1) of the Civil Procedure Rules 1998, or the Court of Protection, or on behalf of a person where the payment can only be disposed of by order or direction of any such court;]
 - (b) in accordance with an order under Rule 36.14 of the Ordinary Cause Rules 1993 ^{F2} or under Rule 128 of those Rules; or
 - (c) in accordance with the terms of a trust established for the benefit of the claimant or his partner,

the whole of the amount so administered.
