Restrictions on trade in things from areas where measures have been disapplied

- **32.** Unless he is licensed by a veterinary inspector, no person shall supply any of the following for [F1 export outside the United Kingdom] if it has come from premises in respect of which any of the measures in Schedule 4 or 5 have been disapplied under articles 30 or 31—
 - (a) poultry;
 - (b) other captive birds;
 - (c) hatching eggs;
 - (d) used litter;
 - (e) manure;
 - (f) slurry.
