The Crime Prevention (Designated Areas) Order 2006

Interpretation

2. In this Order, “the map” means the map numbered 86 and entitled “Map referred to in the Crime Prevention (Designated Areas) Order 2006”, of which a print signed on behalf of the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs is deposited at the offices of—

- (a) the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, and
- (b) the highway authority for the area hatched and edged red on that map.
