The Social Security (Contributions) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2006

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(2) and (3) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992(1), with the concurrence of the Secretary of State, and, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(2) and (3) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992(2), with the concurrence of the Department for Social Development so far as required, make the following Regulations.
