**The Bovine Semen (England) Regulations 2007**

**PART 4**

The collection, processing and storage of semen

**Power of Secretary of State to grant exemptions**

**29.** No person may supply or use semen for artificial insemination if he knows or suspects that it has not been collected, processed or stored in accordance with the requirements of—

- (a) these Regulations,
- (b) lawfully in another part of the United Kingdom; or
- (c) in the case of semen originating [<sup>F1</sup>outside of the United Kingdom], the Directive,

unless authorised by the Secretary of State.
