FOOD, ENGLAND

The Notification of Marketing of Food for Particular Nutritional Uses (England) Regulations 2007

Made - - - - 20th January 2007

Laid before Parliament 1st February 2007

Coming into force - - 1st March 2007

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 17(1), 26(1)(a) and (3) and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990(1), and now vested in her(2). In accordance with section 48(4A) of that Act, she has had regard to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency.

As required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety(3), there has been open and transparent public consultation during the preparation and evaluation of these Regulations.
