# 2007 No. 1943

## The Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) (England and Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 2007

### Title, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) (England and Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2007.

(2) In these Regulations “the 2001 Regulations” means the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) (England and Northern Ireland) Regulations 2001 <sup>M1</sup>.

### Amendment of the 2001 Regulations

2.—(1) The 2001 Regulations are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 2(1), replace the definitions of “Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1622/2000”, “Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1623/2000”, “Commission Regulation (EC) No. 883/2001”, “Commission Regulation (EC) No. 884/2001”, “Commission Regulation (EC) No. 753/2002” and “Council Regulation (EC) No. 1493/1999”<sup>M2</sup> with the following definitions—

““Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1622/2000” means Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1622/2000<sup>M3</sup> laying down certain detailed rules for implementing Regulation (EC) No. 1493/1999 on the common organisation of the market in wine and establishing a Community code on oenological practices and processes, and references in Schedules 2 and 5 to “Regulation 1622/2000” shall be construed accordingly;”;

““Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1623/2000” means Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1623/2000<sup>M4</sup> laying down detailed rules for implementing Regulation (EC) No. 1493/1999 on the common organisation of the market in wine with regard to market mechanisms, and the reference in Part I of Schedule 2 to “Regulation 1623/2000” shall be construed accordingly;”;

““Commission Regulation (EC) No. 883/2001” means Commission Regulation (EC) No. 883/2001<sup>M5</sup> laying down detailed rules for implementing Council Regulation (EC) No. 1493/1999 as regards trade with third countries in products in the wine sector, and the reference in Part V of Schedule 2 to “Regulation 883/2001” shall be construed accordingly;”;

““Commission Regulation (EC) No. 884/2001” means Commission Regulation (EC) No. 884/2001<sup>M6</sup> laying down detailed rules of application concerning the documents accompanying the carriage of wine products and the records to be kept in the wine sector, and the reference in Part I of Schedule 2 to “Regulation 884/2001” shall be construed accordingly;”;

““Commission Regulation (EC) No. 753/2002” means Commission Regulation (EC) No. 753/2002<sup>M7</sup> laying down certain rules for applying Council Regulation (EC) No. 1493/1999 as regards the description, designation, presentation and protection of certain wine sector products;”;

““Council Regulation (EC) No. 1493/1999” means Council Regulation (EC) No. 1493/1999<sup>M8</sup> on the common organisation of the market in wine, and references in Schedules 2 and 5 to “Regulation 1493/1999” shall be construed accordingly;”.

(3) For Schedule 1, substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(4) In Schedule 3, insert the following entries at the appropriate places—

Acolon		Black
Cabernet Sauvignon		Black
Frühburgunder	Pinot Noir Précoce	Black
Merlot		Black

(5) In Schedule 5 omit—

(a) paragraph 2; and

(b) the first sentence of paragraph 7.

(6) In Schedule 6<sup>M9</sup>, omit the entry in columns 1 and 2 of the table relating to total dry extract (obtained by densimetry).
