**The Patient Information Advisory Group (Establishment)  
(Amendment) Regulations 2007**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers in sections 252(4) and 272(7) and (8) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a), makes the following Regulations:—

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Patient Information Advisory Group (Establishment) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and shall come into force on 31st August 2007.

**Amendment of regulation 3 of the Patient Information Advisory Group (Establishment) Regulations 2001**

2. In regulation 3(2) of the Patient Information Advisory Group (Establishment) Regulations 2001(b) (maximum period of membership of the Advisory Group) for “six years” there is substituted “nine years”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations, made under sections 252(4) and 272(7) and (8) of the National Health Service Act 2006 extend the maximum period for which a person may be a member of the Patient Information Advisory Group from six to nine years. They apply only to England and Wales.

A full regulatory impact assessment has not been prepared for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.

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
