The Education (Student Fees, Awards and Support) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2007

The Secretary of State for Innovation, Universities and Skills makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1 and 2 of the Education (Fees and Awards) Act 1983⁽¹⁾, sections 22, 42(6) and 43(1) of the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998⁽²⁾ and sections 24 and 47 of the Higher Education Act 2004⁽³⁾:
