- **3.** In column 1 in fee 8.2 in Schedule 1 in the Schedule omit the words "(excluding VAT and disbursements)".
 - **4.** For paragraph 2(1)(b) in Schedule 1A in the Schedule substitute—
 - "(b) is in receipt of legal advice and assistance under Part II or Part III of the Legal Aid Act 1988 in connection with the matter to which the proceedings relate; or".
