**The Social Security (Contributions)
(Amendment No. 9) Regulations 2007**

The Treasury make these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3(2) and (3) and 175(4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992⁽¹⁾ and sections 3(2) and (3), 170 and 171(4) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992⁽²⁾ and now vested in them.

The Secretary of State and the Department for Social Development concur in the making of these Regulations.

Section 3 has been amended: the relevant amendment is that made by paragraph 3 of Schedule 3 to the [Social Security Contributions \(Transfer of Functions, etc.\) Act 1999](#) (c. 2: “the Transfer Act”). Section 175(4) has been amended by paragraph 29(1) and (4) of Schedule 3 to the Transfer Act.
- (2) 1992 c. 7. Section 3 has been amended: the relevant amendment is that made by paragraph 4 of Schedule 3 to the Social Security Contributions (Transfer of Functions, etc.) (Northern Ireland) Order 1999 ([S.I. 1999/671](#)). Section 170 is cited because of the definition of “the Department” (i.e. the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland). The functions of the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland under the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992 (c. 7) and the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act 1992 (c. 8) were transferred to the Department for Social Development by Article 8(b) of and Part II of Schedule 6 to the Departments (Transfer and Assignment of Functions) Order (Northern Ireland) 1999 ([S.R. 1999 No. 481](#)). There are amendments to section 171 but none is relevant for present purposes.
