##### Amendment of the Poisons Act 1972

**153.** In the Poisons Act 1972 <sup>M1</sup>, in section 11 (interpretation), in subsection (2), in the definition of “dentist”<sup>M2</sup> omit the words “or a person entered in the list of visiting EEA practitioners under Schedule 4 to that Act”.
