The Plant Health (England) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 2007

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2 and 3(1) of the Plant Health Act 1967(a), now vested in him(b):

Title, commencement, extent and application

- 1. This Order—
 - (a) may be cited as the Plant Health (England) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 2007;
 - (b) comes into force on 21st November 2007; and
 - (c) extends to England and Wales but only applies in England.

Amendments to the Plant Health (England) Order 2005

- 2.—(1) The Plant Health (England) Order 2005(c) is amended as follows.
- (2) In Part B of Schedule 4, in the second column of items 1a, 6a and 20a, omit "originating in any third country".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Plant Health (England) Order 2005 (S.I. 2005/2530) by removing the words "originating in any third country" from the descriptions of certain plant material to which certain landing and movement requirements are applied in Schedule 4 to that Order.

A full regulatory impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.
