**Manner of signifying parental consent to registration**

**11.**—<sup>[F1]</sup>(1) Where a parent, in pursuance of section 17(5)(c) of the Act (acquisition by registration: minors)(1), consents to the registration of a person as a British overseas territories citizen under that provision, the consent shall be expressed in writing and signed by the parent.

<sup>[F2]</sup>(2) Any consent required to be signified under section 17D(3) of the Act (consent of a person's natural father and mother, or either of them) must be—

- (a) signified in writing, and
- (b) signed by the person signifying it.]
