#### **Citation and commencement**

- 1. This Order—
  - (a) may be cited as the Avian Influenza (H5N1) (Miscellaneous Amendments) Order 2007; and
  - (b) comes into force on 23rd November 2007.

#### Amendment

**2.**—(1) After article 14(2)(j) of the Avian Influenza (H5N1 in Poultry) (England) Order 2006(**3**) insert—

"(ja) raw petfood, within the meaning of paragraph 48 of Annex I to Regulation (EC) No. 1774/2002, which complies with the requirements in Part B of Chapter II of Annex VIII to that Regulation;".
