# FOOD, ENGLAND FOOD, SCOTLAND

The Milk (Cessation of Production) (Revocation) Scheme 2007

Made - - - - 18th February 2007

Laid before Parliament 26th February 2007

Coming into force - - 6th April 2007

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Milk (Cessation of Production) Act 1985(1), makes the following Scheme:

### Title and commencement

**1.** This Scheme may be cited as the Milk (Cessation of Production) (Revocation) Scheme 2007 and comes into force on 6th April 2007.

#### **Revocations**

- 2.—(1) The following Schemes are revoked in relation to England only—
  - (a) the Milk (Partial Cessation of Production) (England and Wales) Scheme 1986(2); and
  - (b) the Milk (Cessation of Production) (England and Wales) Scheme 1987(3).
- (2) The following Schemes are revoked—
  - (a) the Milk (Partial Cessation of Production) (Scotland) Scheme 1986(4); and
  - (b) the Milk (Cessation of Production) (Scotland) Scheme 1987(5).
