**The Milk (Cessation of Production) (Revocation) Scheme 2007**

*Made* - - - - *18th February 2007*  
*Laid before Parliament* *26th February 2007*  
*Coming into force* - - *6th April 2007*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Milk (Cessation of Production) Act 1985(1), makes the following Scheme:

**Title and commencement**

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Milk (Cessation of Production) (Revocation) Scheme 2007 and comes into force on 6th April 2007.

**Revocations**

- 2.—(1) The following Schemes are revoked in relation to England only—
- (a) the Milk (Partial Cessation of Production) (England and Wales) Scheme 1986(2); and
  - (b) the Milk (Cessation of Production) (England and Wales) Scheme 1987(3).
- (2) The following Schemes are revoked—
- (a) the Milk (Partial Cessation of Production) (Scotland) Scheme 1986(4); and
  - (b) the Milk (Cessation of Production) (Scotland) Scheme 1987(5).

(1) 1985 c. 4. Section 5 defines the Minister. The functions of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food were transferred to the Secretary of State by virtue of article 2(2) of S.I. 2002/794. The Secretary of State's power to make a Scheme which extends to Scotland remains exercisable by virtue of section 57(1) of the Scotland Act 1998 (c. 46).
