1. This Order may be cited as the Education (Chief Inspector of Education and Training in Wales) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 1^{st} June 2007.

2. Miss Susan Lewis is hereby re-appointed Her Majesty's Chief Inspector of Education and Training in Wales or Prif Arolygydd Ei Mawrhydi dros Addysg a Hyfforddiant yng Nghymru for a period of six months commencing on 1st June 2007.
