**The Mutilations (Permitted Procedures)  
(England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008**

*Made* - - - - *2nd June 2008*

*Coming into force* - - *3rd June 2008*

The Secretary of State is, in relation to England, the appropriate national authority for the purpose of exercising the powers conferred by section 5(4) of the Animal Welfare Act 2006<sup>(1)</sup>, and makes the following Regulations in exercise of those powers.

The Secretary of State has carried out a consultation in accordance with section 5(5) of that Act.

In accordance with section 61(2) of that Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before, and approved by a resolution of, each House of Parliament.
