The Community Bus (Amendment) Regulations 2008

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 52(1)(a) and 60(1)(e) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981(a) and sections 126(1) and 134 of the Transport Act 1985(b) and by virtue of the Department of Transport (Fees) Order 1988(c).

Representative organisations have been consulted in accordance with section 61(2) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981(d).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Community Bus (Amendment) Regulations 2008 and shall come into force on 1st August 2008.

Amendments

2. In regulation 4(1) of The Community Bus Regulations 1986(e), for “£53” substitute “£55”.

- (a) 1981 c.14 (in these footnotes called “the 1981 Act”). Relevant amendments to sections 52(1)(a) and 60(1) of the 1981 Act were made by the Transport Act 1985 (c.67) (in these footnotes called “the 1985 Act”) and by the Deregulation and Contracting Out Act 1994 (c.40) (in these footnotes called the 1994 Act”), as follows. Section 52(1)(a) of the 1981 Act was amended by paragraphs 4(1) and 4(14) of Part II of Schedule 2 of the 1985 Act; section 60(1) of the 1981 Act was amended by paragraphs 4(1) and 4(18) of Part II of Schedule 2 of the 1985 Act and words were omitted from section 60(1) of the 1981 Act by Schedule 8 of the 1985 Act. Section 52(1)(a) of the 1981 Act was further amended by section 66(2) of the 1994 Act and section 60(1) (e) of the 1981 Act was substituted by section 66(5) of the 1994 Act. For the definition of “prescribed” and “regulations”, see section 60(2) of the 1981 Act, as amended by the 1985 Act, sections 134(1) and (2) (c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations increase the fee for a community bus permit granted under section 22 of the Transport Act 1985 from £53 to £55. This represents an increase of 3.8%. The fee was last increased on 1st April 2007.
