

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order directs the Football Licensing Authority to include in any licence to admit spectators to the Liberty Stadium, Swansea; the Keepmoat Stadium, Doncaster; and the Don Valley Stadium, Sheffield, a condition imposing the requirements that only seated accommodation is to be provided for spectators at a designated football match and that spectators shall only be admitted to watch such a match from seated accommodation. In order to admit spectators to a designated football match, which would include any association football match played at those grounds, a licence is required under the Football Spectators Act 1989.

A full regulatory impact assessment has not been produced for this Order.
