# The Social Fund Winter Fuel Payment (Temporary Increase) Regulations 2008

Made - - - - 3rd July 2008

Laid before Parliament 10th July 2008

Coming into force - - 15th September 2008

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992(1), sections 138(2) and (4) and 175(1), (3) and (4).

The Social Security Advisory Committee has agreed that proposals in respect of these Regulations should not be referred to it(2).

#### Citation and commencement E+W+S

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Fund Winter Fuel Payment (Temporary Increase) Regulations 2008 and shall come into force on 15th September 2008.

### Modification of the Social Fund Winter Fuel Payment Regulations 2000 E+W+S

- **2.**—(1) For the purpose of making social fund winter fuel payments in respect of the 2008–09 winter, regulation 2 of the Social Fund Winter Fuel Payment Regulations 2000(**3**) (social fund winter fuel payments) is applied as if—
  - (a) the references to £100 (in both places) were to £125;
  - (b) in paragraphs (1)(i), (2)(a) and (3), the reference to £200 were to £250;
