Signature of auditor's report

- **23.**—(1) The auditor's report must state the name of the auditor $[^{FI}(or, where more than one person is appointed as auditor, all of their names)] and be signed and dated.$
 - (2) Where the auditor is an individual, the report must be signed by that individual.
- (3) Where the auditor is a firm, the report must be signed by the senior statutory auditor in his own name, for and on behalf of the auditor.
- [F2(4)] Where more than one person is appointed as auditor, the report must be signed by all of them.]
