# The Adventure Activities Licensing (Amendment) Regulations 2008

the Welsh Ministers(2), acting in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by section 1(4)(f) of the 1995 Act and now vested in them, having consulted persons other than the Health and Safety Executive in accordance with section 3(3) of the 1995 Act and pursuant to a proposal submitted by the Health and Safety Executive under section 3(4) of the 1995 Act.
