TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CONTROLS

End-use control on technical assistance

- **19.**—(1) Subject to article 26, no person shall directly or indirectly provide to a person or place outside the [FIUnited Kingdom] any technical assistance related to the supply, delivery, manufacture, maintenance or use of anything which—
 - (a) that person has been informed by the Secretary of State is or may be intended, in its entirety or in part, for WMD purposes; or
 - (b) that person is aware is intended, in its entirety or in part, for WMD purposes.
- (2) Subject to article 26, no United Kingdom person shall directly or indirectly provide from a place outside the [FIUnited Kingdom] to any person or place outside the [FIUnited Kingdom] any technical assistance related to the supply, delivery, manufacture, maintenance or use of anything which—
 - (a) that person has been informed by the Secretary of State is or may be intended, in its entirety or in part, for WMD purposes; or
 - (b) that person is aware is intended, in its entirety or in part, for WMD purposes.
 - (3) For the purposes of paragraphs (1) and (2)—
 - (a) directly providing technical assistance includes providing technical assistance or agreeing to do so; and
 - (b) indirectly providing technical assistance includes making arrangements under which another person provides technical assistance or agrees to do so.
