The Police Act 1997 (Commencement No. 11) Order 2008

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 135 of the Police Act 1997(a), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and extent

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Police Act 1997 (Commencement No. 11) Order 2008.
- (2) This Order extends to Northern Ireland.
