**The Education (QCA Levy) (Revocation) Regulations 2008**

*Made* - - - - - *25th March 2008*

*Laid before Parliament* *8th April 2008*

*Coming into force* - - - *30th September 2008*

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 36 and 54(3) of the Education Act 1997<sup>(a)</sup>.

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Education (QCA Levy) (Revocation) Regulations 2008 and come into force on 30th September 2008.

**2.** The Education (QCA Levy) Regulations 2002<sup>(b)</sup> and the Education (QCA Levy) (Amendment) Regulations 2002 <sup>(c)</sup> are revoked.
