Savings for provisions relating to execution of documents **U.K.**

7.—(1) The repeal of provisions of section 36A of the Companies Act 1985 ^{M1} (execution of documents) does not affect the operation of that section as applied by the Foreign Companies (Execution of Documents) Regulations 1994 ^{M2}.

(2) That section as so applied does not apply to companies registered in Northern Ireland to which section 44 of the Companies Act 2006 applies.
