**The Companies Act 2006 (Consequential
Amendments etc) Order 2008**

8.—(1) The repeal of provisions of Article 46A of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1986^{M1} (execution of documents) does not affect the operation of that Article—

- (a) in relation to a liquidator of a company^{M2}, or
- (b) as applied by the Foreign Companies (Execution of Documents) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003^{M3}.

(2) That Article as so applied does not apply to companies registered in Great Britain to which section 44 of the Companies Act 2006 applies.
