The Civil Aviation (Customs and Excise Airports) Order 2009

Made - - - - *30th June 2009*

Coming into force - - *1st August 2009*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers under Article 136 of the Air Navigation Order 2005^(a) and with the concurrence of the Commissioners of Revenue and Customs, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Customs and Excise Airports) (Amendment) Order 2009 and comes into force on 1st August 2009.

Amendment of the Civil Aviation (Customs and Excise Airports) Order 2001

2. The Civil Aviation (Customs and Excise Airports) Order 2001^(b) is amended as follows.
3. In Article 2, omit the words “Sheffield City Airport”
