The Secretary of State for Business, Innovation and Skills, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 137, 145 and 210(7) of the Education Act 2002(a), makes the following Regulations.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Further Education (Principals' Qualifications) (England) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2009 and come into force on 23rd October 2009.

**Amendment of the Further Education (Principals' Qualifications) (England) Regulations 2007**

2. The Further Education (Principals' Qualifications) (England) Regulations 2007(b) are amended as set out in regulation 3.

3. In regulation 5(3)(a)(i), for "and", substitute "in circumstances where she".
