The Control of Salmonella in Broiler Flocks Order 2009

Sampling

5.—(1) The occupier must carry out sampling in accordance with points 1 and 2 of the Annex to [^{F1}Commission Regulation (EU) No 200/2012] and must despatch samples to an approved laboratory in accordance with point [^{F2}2.2.4] of that Annex (and for the purposes of that point [^{F3}“express mail”] includes first class post).

(2) In relation to each sample the occupier must provide the following information—

- (a) the name of the occupier;
- (b) the address of the holding;
- (c) the type of samples;
- (d) the date on which the samples were taken;
- (e) the identification of the flock, where there is more than one flock on the holding;
- (f) the date on which the flock moved onto the holding;
- (g) the age of the flock.
