ROAD TRAFFIC

The A19 Trunk Road (The A1058 Coast Road Interchange) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

Made	-	-	12 October 2009
Coming into force	-	-	18 October 2009

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road, in the District of North Tyneside, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because ground investigation works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (The A1058 Coast Road Interchange) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 18 October 2009.

2. In this Order; –

"the A19" means the A19 Trunk Road;

"the southbound carriageway" means the A19 southbound carriageway from a point 150 metres south of the centreline of the A1058 Coast Road Interchange overbridge northwards for a distance of 1550 metres;

"the roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A19/A1058 Coast Road Interchange Roundabout;

"the layby" means an area of carriageway situated adjacent to the A19 northbound carriageway approximately 475 metres south of Coast Road Interchange intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**b**) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 19 October 2009 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the southbound carriageway, or the roundabout.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in the layby.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.
