**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A34 Trunk Road (Three Maids Hill)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

*Made* - - - - *16th November 2009*  
*Coming into force* - - *21st November 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A34 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Three Maids Hill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 21st November 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A34 Trunk Road north of Winchester in the County of Hampshire;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the A34 lay-by” means the lay-by in the northbound carriageway of the trunk road 550 metres north of the slip road leading to the A272 at Three Maids Hill Interchange;

“works” mean carriageway repairs, drainage and associated works on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 23rd November 2009 or on any subsequent day until 20th May 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on, the A34 lay-by.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
