**The Social Security (National Insurance Number Information: Exemption) Regulations 2009**

**Amendment of the Social Security (Maternity Allowance) Regulations 1987**

**4.** For regulation 1A of the Social Security (Maternity Allowance) Regulations 1987<sup>(1)</sup> (disapplication of section 1(1A) of the Administration Act), substitute—

“**1A.** Section 1(1A) of the Social Security Administration Act 1992 (requirement to state a national insurance number) shall not apply to an adult dependant who—

- (a) is a person in respect of whom a claim for an increase of maternity allowance is made;
- (b) is subject to immigration control within the meaning of section 115(9)(a) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999<sup>(2)</sup>; and
- (c) has not previously been allocated a national insurance number.”.
