**The Employment Act 2008 (Commencement No. 2,
Transitional Provisions and Savings) Order 2009**

Citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Employment Act 2008 (Commencement No. 2, Transitional Provisions and Savings) Order 2009.

(2) In this Order:

“the 1948 Act” means the Agricultural Wages Act 1948(1);

“the 1973 Act” means the Employment Agencies Act 1973(2);

“the 1992 Act” means the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992(3);

“the 1998 Act” means the National Minimum Wage Act 1998(4); and

“the Act” means the Employment Act 2008.

Commencement

2. Subject to article 3, sections 8, 9, 11, 12, 18 and 19 of, and Parts 2 and 4 of the Schedule to, the Act shall come into force on 6th April 2009.

Transitional provisions and savings

3. The transitional provisions and savings in the Schedule to this Order shall have effect.
