The Poultry Compartments (England) Order 2010

Power of inspectors

- 4.—(1) An inspector may, for any purpose relating to this Order—
 - (a) enter any premises [F1 approved] as a compartment under this Order and any administrative site which contains records relevant to the [F2 approval] of a site as a compartment;
 - (b) require the keeper to produce or copy any document or record;
 - (c) remove and retain a copy of any document or record;
 - (d) have access to, and check the operation of, any computer and any associated apparatus or material which is or has been used in connection with records;
 - (e) where a record is kept by means of a computer, require the record to be produced in a form which may be taken away;
 - (f) be accompanied by F3... any people or things the inspector considers necessary.
- (2) A person required to do anything by an inspector acting under paragraph (1) must, unless they have reasonable cause, do so without delay.
- (3) For the purposes of this article an inspector means any person approved as an inspector under the Animal Health Act 1981.
