**The A259 Trunk Road (Near Rye) (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2010**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>6th April 2010</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>10th April 2010</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Near Rye) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 10th April 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road near Rye in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 30 metres south of East Guldeford level crossing and 30 metres northeast of Star Level Crossing;

“works” means level crossing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 28½ hours starting at 0030 hours on Saturday 10th April 2010 or on any subsequent Saturday until 3rd July 2010.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
