The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 7(1) and (5) and 41(4) of the Employment Tribunals Act 1996⁽¹⁾, and after consultation with the Administrative Justice and Tribunals Council, and that Council having consulted with the Scottish Committee and the Welsh Committee, in accordance with paragraph 24 of Schedule 7 to the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007⁽²⁾, makes the following Regulations:
