ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Toll Motorway (East of Junction T8) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made---19 April 2010Coming into force-26 April 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Toll Motorway ("the M6 Toll"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway near Cannock in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 Toll Motorway (East of Junction T8) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 26 April 2010.
- 2. In this Order –

"the motorway"	means the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll between a point 250 metres west and a point 600 metres east of the centreline of Saredon Road overbridge;
"the Regulations"	means the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b);
"a hard shoulder"	means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of Regulation $3(1)(e)$ of the Regulations, which is adjacent to the motorway;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 3 May 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.

6. During the works period, regulations 5 and (in so far as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
