**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M60 Motorway (Junction 5, Anticlockwise Exit Slip Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>24 May 2010</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>21 June 2010</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Manchester in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) hereby makes the following Order.

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 5, Anticlockwise Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 21 June 2010.

**2.** In this Order;

“motorway” means the M60 Motorway;

“works” means loop replacement works on the slip road;

“the works period” means a period over two nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Tuesday 22 June 2010 and ending on Tuesday 29 June 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such further period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the anticlockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 5.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
